

RoHS Declaration of Conformity



On 9 May 2013 the revised EU Directive 2011/65/EU (RoHS-II) on restricting the use of hazardous materials in electrical and electronic devices was incorporated into German law with the adoption of the Directive on Substances in Electrical and Electronic Devices (ElektroStoffV). On 4 June 2015, the Commission (EU) completed and published 4 additional substances in the RoHS Directive 2015/863 (RoHS-III).

This affects the following substances

- Lead (0.1 %),
- Cadmium (0.01 %),
- Mercury (0.1 %),
- Hexavalent chromium (0.1 %),
- Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB) (0.1 %)
- Polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE) (0.1 %),
- Bis(2-ethylhexyl) phthalat (DEHP) (0.1 %),
- Butyl benzyl phthalat (BBP) (0.1 %),
- Dibutyl phthalat (DBP) (0.1 %),
- Diisobutyl phthalat (DIBP) (0.1 %).

At the time of this declaration we confirm that all our products meet the requirements of Germany's Directive on Substances in Electrical and Electronic Devices (ElektroStoffV). The limit values set by EU Directive 2011/65/EU for the above-mentioned substances are not exceeded in the manufacture of our products.
