Declaration on the Use of Conflict Minerals



Statement on the use of conflict minerals within the meaning of Section 1502 of the Dodd-Frank Act:

The US Dodd-Frank Act on 'Conflict Minerals' has been legally binding since July 2010. It relates in particular to the minerals tin, tantalum, tungsten and gold and their derivatives, which are mined in conflict areas such as the Democratic Republic of the Congo and neighbouring crisis regions. It also aims, among other things, to restrict or prevent trade in these substances originating from these conflict areas, as the mining and trading of these raw materials finances armed groups.

With this letter, we would like to inform you as a customer of ehb electronics gmbh that we only use electronic parts and components from reputable manufacturers and distributors we have trusted for many years in our products. However, as a manufacturer of end devices, we have no influence on the origin of minerals used by our suppliers. We therefore cannot accept any liability in this respect. We are committed to ensuring traceability and transparency in our suppliers' products.

Should we nevertheless become aware of the use of these minerals, we will immediately initiate countermeasures, demand the immediate replacement of these conflict minerals and ultimately terminate the business relationship with the supplier.

ehb electronics gmbh is aware of its social responsibility with regard to the environment, safety, health and human rights and understands that its behaviour in business transactions has an impact on society and the environment. In order to ensure the peaceful, fair and sustainable use of our global resources, ehb electronics gmbh assures and confirms the following:

We ourselves do not directly import minerals or so-called 'conflict minerals' and therefore, to the best of our current knowledge, no conflict minerals are used in our products.

Furthermore, we do not process any materials for which the country of origin corresponds to one of the countries listed above according to the certificate of origin.
